Not one, but two graduates of Saskatoon Public Schools have received the Lloyd Saunders High School Athletic Scholarship Award presented by the Kinsmen Club of Saskatoon. The \$2,000 scholarship is designated to further the recipient(s) education at the post secondary level. Financial need, outstanding high school athletic involvement, community involvement and service are the selection criteria.

The co-recipients of the 2010 Lloyd Saunders Kinsmen Scholarship are Graham Unruh, a graduate of Evan Hardy Collegiate and Kelsey Gsell, a graduate of Mount Royal Collegiate. The award was announced at the Kinsmen Sports Celebrity Dinner held on February 4th.

Currently enrolled in first year Arts and Science at the University of Saskatchewan, Graham's goal is to become a physical education teacher. He is a member of the Saskatoon Hilltops and was recognized as the top rookie for the team in the 2010 season.

While maintaining a grade point average of 75%, Graham worked with young people at camps and clinics to promote core strength and endurance development as well as skill improvement. Evan Hardy Collegiate is lucky enough to have him as their junior basketball coach this year.

Kelsey Gsell graduated from Mount Royal Collegiate in June 2010. She is currently enrolled in her first year at the University of Guelph, working toward a Bachelor of Science Degree, with honours in Bio Medical Science. She is a member of the Guelph Gryphons Wrestling team and enjoyed her time wrestling with the Mount Royal Mustangs.

An honours student, Kelsey earned a 97% average in grade 12, earning recognition as the top student in a number of subject areas. Her dedication and commitment to academics is respected by both staff and her fellow students. Kelsey was a Saskatoon Public Schools' General Proficiency Award winner in all four grades in high school. She demonstrated outstanding leadership on the Student Representative Council and the Grad Committee in her senior year.
