Bob Shmon, principal of King George Community School, has been named one of Canada's Outstanding Principals by The Learning Partnership.

He is the only recipient from Saskatchewan to receive this award in 2012.

Mr. Shmon receives the award in Toronto on February 28th. He joins 39 other principals from across the country at the National Academy of *Canada's Outstanding Principals* in February.
