## **March 30, 2010 – Caswell Community School students score at provincial math challenge**

Students from Caswell Community School won several awards at the recent Saskatchewan Math Teachers' Society Provincial Math challenge. One student placed 1<sup>st</sup> and one placed 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Grade 8 results and the school's Grade 8 team placed 3<sup>rd</sup> overall.

The Saskatchewan Math Challenge is a provincial math competition co-sponsored by the Saskatchewan Math Teachers' Society and the Universities of Saskatchewan and Regina. Students from grades 7 to 10 compete as individuals and as teams of 3 to 5 in solving problems. The two team rounds encourage collaboration among students as only one answer booklet is collected from each team.

Just over 300 students attend Caswell Community School, which is one of two public schools offering the Academically Talented (AcTal) Program for students in grades 5 to 8.
