Who should come to the Newcomer Student Centre?

- students and their families who are new to Saskatoon Public Schools AND who do not speak English as their first language, including First Nations, Inuit and Métis students
 - *international students with a study permit should contact the International Program at 683-8431*

What does the Newcomer Student Centre do?

- introduces families to our schools
- assesses students' language and mathematics skills
- helps register students in elementary and high schools
- recommends support and programming for students needing EAL (English as an Additional Language) services

Families should bring the following documents to the Newcomer Student Centre:

- **proof of student's age**
(e.g. passport, birth certificate, status card)
- **proof of immigration status**
(e.g. passport, permanent resident card)
- **previous school records** (a certified translation in English for high school students)
- **any other relevant documents**
(e.g. immunization records).
