The Newcomer Student Centre provides newcomer families with a welcoming and supportive introduction to Saskatoon Public Schools.

Who should come to the Newcomer Student Centre?

- All students who are not Canadian citizens
- Students and their families who are new to Saskatoon Public Schools AND who do not speak English as their first language, including First Nations, Inuit and Métis students

What does the Newcomer Student Centre do?

- Introduces families to our schools
- Helps register students in elementary and high schools
- Assesses EAL (English as an Additional Language) students' language skills
- Recommends support and programming for students needing EAL services

Families should bring the following documents to the Newcomer Student Centre:

- proof of student's age
 (e.g. immigration documents, passport, status card, birth certificate,)
- proof of immigration status
 (e.g. immigration documents, passport, permanent resident card)
- previous school records (a certified translation in English for high school students)
- any other relevant documents
