## ENGLISH

The school year will begin Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup>, at 9:00 a.m., for all grades.

Students will be dismissed on this day at 10:00 a.m.

Regular classes for grades 1 – 8 begin Tuesday, September 1<sup>st</sup>

The regular school day for 2009/2010 is:

MORNING:	First bell at 8:55 a.m., classes start at 9:00 a.m. Dismissal for lunch at 11:45 p.m.
AFTERNOON:	First bell at 12:40 p.m., classes begin at 12:45 Dismissal at 3:30 p.m. Buses depart at 3:40 p.m.
Common Early Dismissal for staff meetings.	2:45 p.m. every Thursday / buses depart at 2:55

Kindergarten students have been informed of a “Staggered Start” on September 2 and 3. Their regular classes will begin on Thursday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>.

### Fees:

Student fees for each grade are noted on the bottom of the supply list. The fees have been calculated as closely as possible to cover such things as cost of student insurance, student planner/handbook, materials for special projects, and out-of-school tips. Band students are asked to include \$20 for workbooks and other band costs.

As you can appreciate, there will be new teachers in the fall and some activities may change. Therefore, there may be a need to request minimal amounts of money throughout the school year for such things as unanticipated excursions. Special activities may require more funds. These activities may include camp, downhill skiing (where applicable), and Grade 8 Farewell. **Teachers will explain how the money will be used.**

Please submit money for school fees, (cheques **payable to College Park School**) to your teacher as soon as possible, and **no later than October 1, 2010**. If this is not possible, please talk to us in September about other arrangements. One cheque may be used to cover all family members attending our school. Please note the students' names and grades on the cheque.

### Supplies:

In the spirit of conservation, you may be able to reuse items purchased during the last school last year. Items will have to be replenished throughout the school year as they are used up or lost! **Clothing and footwear should be clearly labeled with your child's name.**

For gym apparel, all students will require: 1 pair of running shoes with light colored soles that do **not** mark a tile floor; Grades 5-8 require 1 T-shirt, 1 pair of shorts, and deodorant. Gym clothes should be in a gym bag.

Students in grades 7 and 8 are required to supply a combination lock. Students in other middle years grades may be assigned lockers and if so, will be requested to supply a combination lock.
