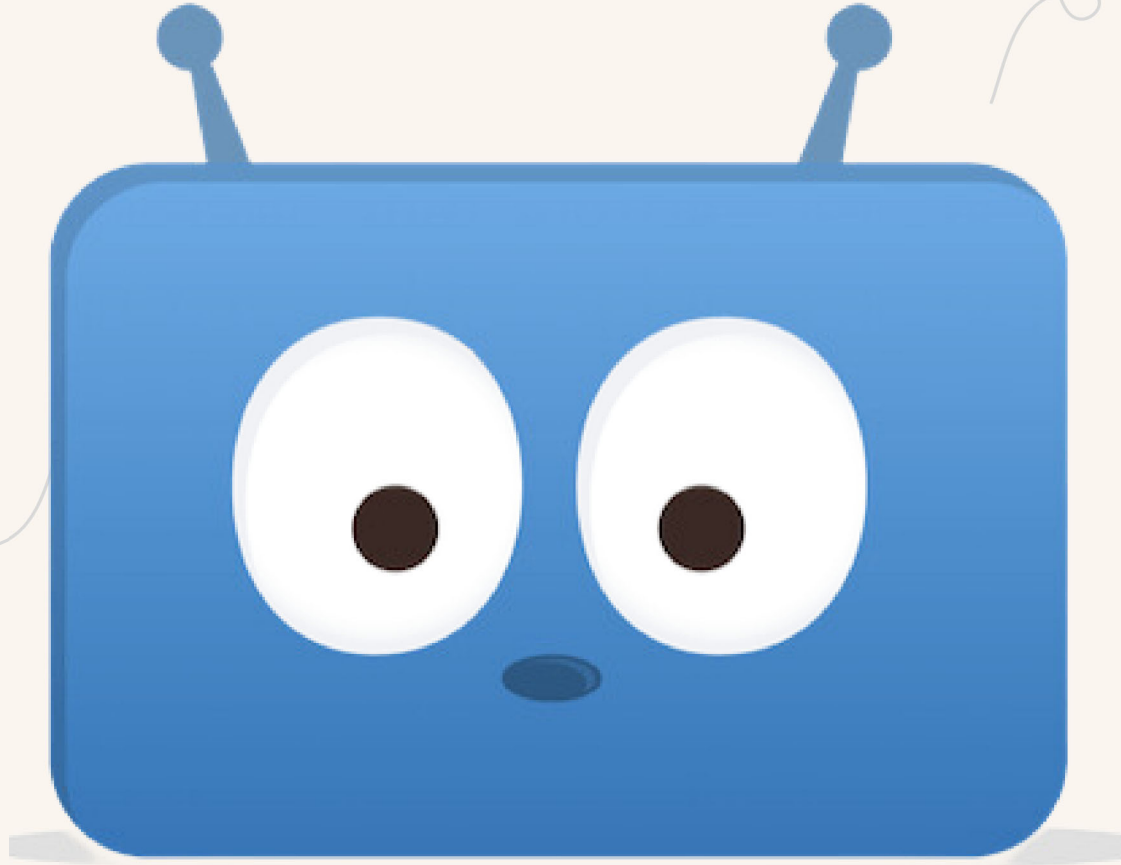

Our Purpose

- ★ To aid parents who require child care because they are working, attending classes or other activities.
- ★ To provide safe, caring, and secure childcare with meaningful activities for the school community.
- ★ To provide children the opportunity grow & develop their friendships with peers through positive interaction.





Kinder-Care

- ★ The Kinder-Care Program is an extension of the Before & After School Program and includes both a learning component as well as a social interactive component.
- ★ We operate everyday Monday – Friday opposite the times of the normal Kindergarten Day. There is a morning class of Kinder-Care which runs from 9:00am to 12:40pm, and an afternoon class which runs from 11:55am – 3:30 pm (provided there is enough enrolment.)
- ★ Children can attend on a full time or part time basis.
- ★ The 2024/2025 School Year marks 21 years that the Kinder-Care program has been in operation at Ecole Lakeview School.
- ★ Some of the various and exciting activities we do each day include learning nursery rhymes, learning about letters, numbers, our community, arts, and crafts, and reading. We also use a portion of our day for physical activities and social interactions with classmates. We are also very much a part of the school culture where the Kinder-Care students attend assemblies and other activities that take place in the school.

The emphasis is on encouraging constructive use of leisure time in a safe and caring environment.



Before and After Care

- ★ The Before & After School Program is open to all students at Ecole Lakeview School including Kindergarten students.
- ★ We provide supervised childcare before school (7:30 a.m. until 9:00 a.m.) and after school (3:30 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.), Monday through Friday.
- ★ Children can attend on a full time or part time basis.
- ★ The program runs out of our classroom, which is Classroom #2.
- ★ The program includes a variety of activities such as free playtime, crafts, sports and games, cooking, going to the gym and going outside when the weather is nice.
- ★ •As we are a larger program students are typically put in two groups which consist of Kindergarten - Grade 2, and then Grades 3 and up.
- ★ There are always 1 - 2 staff in the mornings and 3 - 4 staff afterschool.
- ★ We are also open for Full Days during PD/Planning Days and 3-Way Conference Days. The only time the program is not in operation is during Christmas Break, February Break, Easter, Summer or any Stat holiday.

★ **CURRENT FEES as of 2023 - 2024 School Year. Fees for the upcoming 2024 - 2025 School Year will be decided in May/June of 2024.**

★ \$40.00 - ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE PER FAMILY

★ \$70.00 - MINIMUM MONTHLY FEE

★ \$50.00 - LATE FEE FOR UNPAID INVOICES

Please note that you can combine Full Time and Casual rates as based on your child's attendance in the program. An example of this would be if a child came full time in the morning and casually after school, that is what you will be billed for, as days that your child attends will be kept track of via attendance each day. Another example would be if your child attends Kinder-Care Full Time, they can attend either before or after school on a casual basis and that is what you will be billed for.



Next Steps

- ★ Registration forms as well as the programs Policy Manual is found in the Kindergarten Info package
- ★ Fill out the registration forms and return them as soon as you can. Preferably by the Kindergarten open house in May/June.
- ★ Forms can be dropped off at the school or emailed to lesdpwilliams@hotmail.com
- ★ Registration fee will be collected in September 2024
- ★ Registration can be at any time throughout the year. It is important that if you know you will utilize the program to register early for planning for staff in the fall as well as planning classes with Kindergarten teachers
- ★ If at any time you have any questions regarding the program, you can email me or phone me at any time. My numbers are located on my business card in the Kindergarten package
