Brightwater Cabin Cleaning Checklist

Please note: Cabin cleaning should occur with adult supervision

- Please get a blue cleaning kit from Murdy. Brooms and dust pans are in the cabin. The kit should contain a cloth, yellow gloves, disinfectant spray, cleaning solution, garbage bags and an ice cream pail.
- Move all gear out of the cabin and set it where the bus will pick you up – most likely at the top of the hill. If it is raining, check with Murdy.
- Make sure there isn't any clothing, garbage, items on the floor or graffiti in the cabin.
- Spray each mattress with disinfectant. Set each mattress upright to dry.
- Sweep the floor with the broom and dump in the garbage.
- Dump the contents of all garbage into ONE container and tie a knot in that bag. Take that bag to the white garbage bin by the compost bin. If you are unsure where this is, please ask.
- Put one cap of cleaning solution and an ice cream pail of water into mop bucket. Mop the floor. Dump the mop water down the toilet. Flush.
- Make sure all the lights are turned off.
- Please have the adult supervisor, with assistance from students, clean the washroom in each cabin. The Site managers will clean the Dining Hall washrooms.
- Murdy Hutton, site manager for the Salvation Army, will now inspect your cabin.
