Trustees approve next step in City Centre Project

At its meeting May 10, the Board of Education passed a motion to close Princess Alexandra School as plans progress for the new centrally located school to serve the area.

The site of Princess Alexandra School was chosen by the board as the location for the division's next school. Referred to as the City Centre Project until it is officially named, the new school will bring together the communities of King George, Pleasant Hill, and Princess Alexandra schools. In preparation for construction, the Princess Alexandra building must be demolished, which is expected to begin this fall.

Design work for the City Centre Project is progressing as the school division continues to meet with potential partners for the facility.

Other meeting highlights included:

- Grade 5 students from Holliston School shared their <u>Stand Tall for Peace project</u> during the Celebrating Excellence portion of the meeting. The class created a sunflower mural, performed a song in sign language about world peace, and distributed 450 "Seeds for Peace" letters in the community. These letters contained sunflower seeds and a request that people grow sunflowers as a symbol of solidarity with the people of Ukraine. Sunflowers are Ukraine's national flower and a symbol of peace.
- The school division will use \$483,462 of federal funding to provide improved ventilation in existing schools through the purchase of recommended MERV 13 filters and equipment to improve the measurement of air pressure in existing ductwork. Work is to be completed by this fall.
