Classes Resume Wednesday at Caswell School

Classes will resume Wednesday at Caswell School following repairs to a water main break in the neighbourhood.

Water service has been restored to the school. Student families are being notified.

As is normal procedure following a water main break, the school is under a precautionary drinking water advisory. This advisory is put in place to ensure there is no contamination to the water line following the water main break. The advisory is expected to be in place for a few days while water sampling is completed.

The school will follow the guidelines set out by the Saskatchewan Health Authority. As a precaution, water in the school cannot be consumed. Until the advisory is lifted, parents and caregivers of students are being asked to send a reusable water bottle with tap water from home for their child to drink during the school day.
