Brevoort Park School moving to Level 4

Saskatoon Public Schools is temporarily moving Brevoort Park School to Level 4 of the provincial Safe Schools Plan, following consultation with the Saskatchewan Health Authority.

Students will move to remote learning starting Monday, May 3. In-school learning is expected to resume Monday, May 17.

Brevoort Park School has five active cases of COVID-19 variants of concern, the most recent of which was identified today.

Since the start of the school year, Saskatoon Public Schools has had 315 positive cases of COVID-19 at 58 locations in the division – 57 schools and the board office.

The safety of our students and staff members is our priority. The safety protocols our schools have in place are critical to reducing the risk of transmission. Mask requirements, proper hand hygiene, physical distancing when possible, and cohorting classes are all measures our schools have implemented to help protect students and staff members. These measures will significantly reduce the spread of the virus. Saskatoon Public Schools encourages everyone in our school communities to follow provincial public health orders.

Saskatoon Public Schools is the largest school division in the province. We operate 49 elementary schools, 10 secondary schools, one associate school and one alliance school.
