Outbreak declared at École College Park School

The Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) has declared an outbreak at École College Park School.

The SHA notified the school division about the outbreak declaration on Tuesday. Communication about the outbreak declaration has been shared with students, staff, and the school community. Classes at the school will resume on Monday, January 4 as scheduled.

To date, École College Park School has had four positive cases of COVID-19. Last week, four classrooms were closed due to isolation orders. All four will re-open when classes resume in January.

Since the start of the school year, Saskatoon Public Schools has had 158 positive cases at 45 locations in the division – 44 schools and the board office.

The safety of our students and staff members is our first priority. The safety protocols our schools have put in place are critical to reducing the risk of transmission. Mask requirements, proper hand hygiene, physical distancing when possible, and cohorting classes are all measures our schools have implemented to help protect students and staff members. These measures will significantly reduce the spread of the virus.
