Outbreak declared at Lawson Heights School

The Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) has declared an outbreak at Lawson Heights School.

The SHA notified the school division about the outbreak declaration today. Communication about the outbreak declaration has been shared with students, staff, and the school community. Classes at the school will continue as scheduled.

To date this school year Saskatoon Public Schools has been notified of two positive cases of COVID-19 at Lawson Heights School, the most recent on March 11.

The school division was notified of seven positive cases of COVID-19 during the weekend — two at Sylvia Fedoruk School, two at Chief Whitecap School, and one each at Ernest Lindner, Hugh Cairns V.C., and Princess Alexandra schools. Since the start of the school year, Saskatoon Public Schools has had 257 positive cases at 54 locations in the division – 53 schools and the board office.

The safety of our students and staff members is our priority. The safety protocols our schools have put in place are critical to reducing the risk of transmission. Mask requirements, proper hand hygiene, physical distancing when possible, and cohorting classes are all measures our schools have implemented to help protect students and staff members. These measures will significantly reduce the spread of the virus.

Saskatoon Public Schools is the largest school division in the province. We operate 49 elementary schools, 10 secondary schools, one associate school and one alliance school.
