### Outbreak declared at North Park Wilson School

The Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) has declared an outbreak at North Park Wilson School.

The SHA notified the school division about the outbreak declaration today. Communication about the outbreak declaration has been shared with students, staff, and the school community. Classes at the school will continue as scheduled.

To date, North Park Wilson School has had three positive cases of COVID-19 this school year, the most recent of which was identified today. One classroom is currently closed due to an isolation order.

Since the start of the school year, Saskatoon Public Schools has had 194 positive cases at 48 locations in the division – 47 schools and the board office.

The safety of our students and staff members is our first priority. The safety protocols our schools have put in place are critical to reducing the risk of transmission. Mask requirements, proper hand hygiene, physical distancing when possible, and cohorting classes are all measures our schools have implemented to help protect students and staff members. These measures will significantly reduce the spread of the virus.

Saskatoon Public Schools is the largest school division in the province. We operate 49 elementary schools, 10 secondary schools, one associate school and one alliance school.
