### Saskatoon Misbah School moving to Level 4

Saskatoon Public Schools is temporarily moving Saskatoon Misbah School to Level 4 of the provincial Safe Schools Plan following consultation with the board and administration of Saskatoon Misbah School as well as the Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA).

Students will move to remote learning starting Tuesday, May 25. In-school learning is expected to resume Monday, June 7.

Saskatoon Misbah School, a Saskatoon Public Schools' associate school, has three active cases of COVID-19 variants of concern. All three cases were identified during the weekend.

Since the start of the school year, Saskatoon Public Schools has had 360 positive cases of COVID-19 at 58 locations in the division – 57 schools and the board office.

The safety of our students and staff members is our priority. The safety protocols our schools have in place are critical to reducing the risk of transmission. Mask requirements, proper hand hygiene, physical distancing when possible, and cohorting classes are all measures our schools have implemented to help protect students and staff members. These measures will significantly reduce the spread of the virus. Saskatoon Public Schools encourages everyone in our school communities to follow provincial public health orders.

Saskatoon Public Schools is the largest school division in the province. We operate 49 elementary schools, 10 secondary schools, one associate school and one alliance school.
