Statement from the Director of Education

The following is a statement from Director of Education Barry MacDougall:

“I have formally asked Corey O’Soup, Saskatchewan’s Advocate for Children and Youth, to conduct an investigation into the death of our student at École Dundonald School. This is an extraordinary tragedy, which I believe requires an extraordinary response.

“At Saskatoon Public Schools, we pride ourselves on the ethic of care we provide to every student in order to ensure their safety and well-being. In order to do everything we can to appropriately examine the circumstances of our student’s death, our organization has requested this independent review of our pertinent operations. We must learn from this tragedy so it never happens again.

“Our internal investigation continues and the Office of the Chief Coroner will complete its investigation.”
