# Award of Excellence recipient exemplifies division's vision, goals

#### Other meeting highlights included:

- Trustees received a report on how the division's Counselling, Behaviour, and Safe Schools branch is focusing on student well-being. That includes Safe, Caring and Accepting Schools efforts around areas such as healthy relationships and diversity. There has also been additional emphasis on supporting students, staff, and families who are experiencing increased anxiety.
- Senior administration updated the ongoing response to the COVID-19 pandemic, with student and staff safety the top priority. The Level 3 status of large collegiates, isolation period for positive COVID cases, and Saskatchewan Health Authority notification process were part of the update.
