Schools to welcome new students at Early Registration Day

Saskatoon Public Schools is welcoming new students and families at Early Registration Day on Thursday, August 29 at all elementary schools.

Running from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., the event allows students and families who are new to the school division, or who are transferring from another school, to take a tour, ask questions and register at their new elementary school. Families of students who were registered at their school during the previous school year do not need to attend Early Registration Day.

“The first day of school is hectic and can be overwhelming for new students,” said Division Principal Nicola Bishop-Yong. “Early Registration Day provides a quieter atmosphere so new students and families can ask questions of staff members, take a tour of their new school, and complete registration. This will help students feel comfortable in their new school and ready to start on their learning journey on the first day of classes.”

Collegiates are open for early registration starting today when counsellors and administrators are back in the office. New students in Grade 9-12 or students who have not yet registered for fall classes should phone the collegiate to book an appointment.

The first full day of classes for high school students is Tuesday, Sept. 3. Elementary students will attend school for the morning only on September 3, with their first full day on September 4.
