



Aden Bowman student awarded Canada's largest undergraduate scholarship Schulich Leader Scholarships support Canada's top talent in Science, Engineering and Math (STEM)

Abhinav Menon, a Grade 12 student at Aden Bowman Collegiate, has been selected to receive a \$100,000 **Schulich Leader Scholarship** to study sciences majoring in chemistry at the University of British Columbia. Menon was selected for his outstanding academic and extra-curricular achievements.

Program founder Seymour Schulich says: "Schulich Leader Scholarships enable Canada's top universities to attract and retain our exceptional STEM talent here at home, empowering them to become the innovators and entrepreneurs our country needs. When these scholars go on to drive prosperity and strengthen our economy, Canada must ensure the right economic conditions exist so they can build their promising futures here. Supporting their entrepreneurial ambition is essential for turning Canadian ingenuity into lasting national success."

A total of 100 scholarships are being awarded: 50 engineering scholarships valued at \$120,000 each, and 50 science, technology or math scholarships valued at \$100,000 each.

Abhinav Menon says: "I received the offer while I was at school and the first people I shared with were the teachers and counsellors who supported me. This scholarship has given me financial security and enables me to focus on my studies without financial stress. As well, the Schulich community has leaders who I can be inspired from and collaborate with."
