OUR PROGRAMS AND INITIATIVES INCLUDE:

- The Early Learner Tutor Program pairs struggling young readers in grades one to three with an experienced tutor for twenty hours of intensive one-to-one reading support to help children progress toward grade level reading.
- Summer Reading Camp is a two week program designed to engage young learners and prevent learning loss over the summer months. Each summer over 200 children take part in a camp at one of fourteen sites across Saskatoon Public Schools.
- The Nutrien Food4Thought Nutrition Program provides nearly 760,000 nutritious meals and snacks each year to students from nineteen schools, providing the nutrition needed to be successful in the classroom.
- · Annual grants to schools to support innovative, high-impact initiatives that enhance the curriculum.
- SPS Foundation capital projects include the Cameco Centre of Excellence in Science and Mathematics, a state-of-the-art facility in Bedford Road Collegiate for students interested in careers in science, technology, engineering and mathematics, and the Nutrien Eco-Science and Indigenous Learning Centre at Brightwater, where thousands of students visit each year to take part in experiential, land-based learning and Indigenous Knowledge programming.
