HOMESTAY AN ENRICHING CANADIAN EXPERIENCE

Homestay provides international students with an enriching, authentic Canadian experience in a welcoming home environment. A home environment in Saskatoon provides the perfect setting for practicing and developing English language skills and experiencing Canadian culture first hand.

A Homestay Coordinator and SIE staff work proactively and collaboratively to ensure each student has an excellent homestay experience.

There is a very thorough process for screening and selecting potential host families:

- Students' interests, personalities, and needs are matched with those of host families.
- Accommodations for students will be arranged in safe and secure family homes, within proximity to schools and public transportation.
- Each student is provided with a private furnished bedroom, easily accessible bathroom and 3 meals per day.
- Legal custodianship is provided for homestay students under the age of 19. SIE acts as custodian.

In the event of an emergency, international students and their parents have access to the Homestay Coordinator and the Program Director who are committed to students' well-being and provide resources and support 24-hours a day.
