Since 2007, all Saskatoon Public School Division schools have had a **School Community Council** as part of their governance structure. An SCC (like a PTA) exists to:

- Provide one more way for parents to talk with school administrators, openly discuss their ideas and have input into their children's education
- Promote a positive educational environment by developing activities which build community
- Offer interested parents an opportunity to participate in initiatives that support learning

## Who can attend SCC meetings?

SCC meetings are public. **All parents, guardians, teachers and community members are invited and encouraged to attend.** Those who opt to take up board positions make a commitment, but there are no formal memberships or requirements of any kind to attend meetings.

## Past SCC activities include:

- **Diversity Dinner**- now a favorite yearly event celebrating the wide array of cultures in our school community.
- **Winter Concert**- a Lakeview community celebration of holiday music for all
- **Book and Bannock** literacy breakfasts
- Fall **Scholastic Book Fairs** provide needed financial support to library and a literary "shopportunity" for students and parents
- **Summer Reading Book Exchange**, now an annual tradition, celebrating both reading and sharing
- **Year-end Family Picnic** brought families and friends to Lakeview Park to enjoy an annual celebratory BBQ and picnic lunch.
- **Parent Information Nights** on specific topics that are relevant to parents, care givers and students.

## SCC funds support things like:

- 😊 replenishing classroom **activity buckets** with fun equipment that gets kids moving during recesses
- 😊 supplying **non-perishable food items** for 'backup' snacks and lunches for students
- 😊 **wheelchair basketball** to help students experience how folks of varying levels of abilities can stay active and have fun
- 😊 **Day of Pink** Tshirts to celebrate of mutual respect and understanding
- 😊 **Indigenous Culture Night**, an evening marking the end to two amazing days of hands-on learning about indigenous culture for students. We were proud to be a part of this new way of sharing indigenous culture with our Lakeview community.
- 😊 **Math manipulatives** help students learn new math concept and provide a visual aid while learning.
