- 2. SGI will email the student with a MySGI activation code. Please set up a MySGI account at www.mysgi.ca using the student email address provided on the SGI Signature Form. The MySGI account must be set up before the Driver Education Class starts.

**DOCUMENTATION:** You must have a birth certificate or valid passport before you can take the course. No photocopied ID will be accepted. This documentation will be required for the eye exam that will take place during the class. If you do not have documentation, please inform the office as soon as possible so you can be placed in a later class once a birth certificate is obtained.

**ATTENDANCE** is very important as SGI has a strict policy. If you are not attending the class, you will be removed, and SGI will suspend your license.

PLEASE NOTE: Any student who is removed from the class due to absences will not be allowed entrance to another class at any other time. SGI has stated they will only provide funding for one course per student during high school.
