




Daily Check

Our school is still the same great place!


• There are just some changes...we will learn these together and will be very good at following our new norms in no time...

- Have them practice talking to others with their masks on








A few new routines...





SCHOOL DAY Schedule:

- 8:50 BELL #1 rings for BLUE Cohort to line up at their TEACHER meeting spot outside and away from door
- Teacher will bring students into the school
 2M apart
- 8:55 BELL #2 rings for YELLOW
 Cohort to line up at their TEACHER
 meeting spot outside and away from door
- Teachers will bring students into the school socially distanced



Students Entering School!

- Your children will enter school differently
- They will use the same doors to enter school, exit and go outside at recess time
- We will practice these daily and teachers will meet students in their SPOTS every morning
- Please practice so your children know which doors to use
- If you have more than one child here, help them choose a spot outside to meet after school each day

Kindergarten


- This door leads directly into the Kindergarten room

- Each student will be invited to come in and wash their hands one at a time





• Each class will have a Recess Bucket similar to this with equipment only their class will use




Playground Structure

STAGGERED SCHOOL START

- Students are invited to attend as follows:
- **A-K** (student last names) will come to school for the FULL day September 8th and 10th
- L-Z (student last names) will come to school for the FULL day September 9th and 11th
- ALL students begin school September
 14th
- Teachers will phone families either the 3rd or the 4th to let them know where to meet in the morning!



STAGGERED START

- September 8th Last name families A-K– Blue group
- September 9th Last name
 families L-Z Yellow group
- September 10th **Blue** group will attend full day
- September 11th **Yellow** group will attend full day

Lunch Time

- Our lunch break begins at 11:50 and ends at 12:40
- Our preference is for students to **go home** for lunch
- Students who must stay for lunch must be able to open containers and wrappers on their own and will take all recycling and garbage home with them
- Students who go home for lunch join students in their PLAYGROUND ZONE when they return before the bell rings






PARENT PICK UP SPOT

 drop off and pick up




Kindergarten Staggered Start

- Your child's teacher will let you know what to bring on the 8 and 10th, 9th and 11th when they contact you




2M Distancing in School

- We will teach our students about social distancing in school and will practice this daily!
- Our students will learn to walk, work, learn and respect each other's space
- Traffic will travel counter-clockwise throughout the school
- All movement will be led by teachers

Hygiene


- Please have your children practice washing their hands:
 - When they walk in the door
 - Before they eat
 - After they eat
 - Before they leave your house
- Before doing hair, brushing teeth, putting on glasses, fixing hat, etc.
- Singing the ABCs is the length of time for washing





Santization


- Our Building Operator will be sanitizing the school 4 times daily
- Desks, doorknobs, light switches, handrails, dispensers, counters, pencil sharpeners, taps, sinks, will all be part of these rotations
- Classroom desks, workspaces, computers will be cleaned by teachers and helpers
